Welcome to the 2023-2024 Home School Enrichment school year! I am Allyson Day (or Señora Day as you will hear your children say), and I am excited to be your child's Spanish teacher this year! I have lived and taught in West Des Moines all my life. I studied Elementary Education and

Spanish at Drake University. I have five children ranging in age from 23 to 31, and four grandchildren!

Based on the student population of each class, I will teach with a combination of review/practice of what the students have previously learned along with many NEW language concepts, vocabulary, and culture. I will teach and review basic conversational Spanish throughout the year. Body, clothing, animals, and landforms will be the big units in the elementary grades this year! NOTE: If your child is new to Spanish this year, please tell them not to worry that they will be behind! I am very careful to ease the transition and help them feel comfortable!

It also serves as a collection of their work. Please take time to have your child share the work that they've done each week. This is a great way to encourage and build your child's confidence as a writer. On occasion, students will need to complete work at home that they started in class. Many
